INFORMATION CONCERNING THE PROGRAMME

Saturday 22nd Oct.

Arrival of the Spanish participants

Teachers and families will pick you up at the Bologna Marconi Airport at **9:20**. You'll spend the day and Sunday together.

Sunday 23rd Oct.

Arrival of the Portuguese participants

Teachers and families will pick you up at the Bologna Marconi Airport at **16:55**. You'll spend the day with the families.

Teachers may have dinner with us at 19:30 at Baiocco pizzeria.

Monday 24th Oct.

Welcome and Ice Breaking Activities

8-10> At school with the prof.sse De Col, Maccaferri and Frignani: we will show you the school buildings and areas, offices, and machinery part. Our students may remain in their classes and reach us at 11.

10-10:30> Break.

11-13> We will introduce you to the headmaster, dott.ssa Annamaria Barone Freddo (welcoming and dissemination through the students), presents exchange and explanation of the week programme. Activities altogether: discussion about the project topics.

13> Lunch at home and chill.

18-20> **DISSEMINATION&APERICENA** at school (it's on us!): we will have some Italian baked specialties, together with some teachers and your parents are invited, too!

Tuesday 25th Oct.

Conference and workshop with the expert + BOLOGNA

8-10> Dott. Alessandro Mingotti, teacher at the University of Ferrara, will show us some of the usages of water in the industrial and electrical fields.

10:15> Break.

10:30-11:30> Discussion, working groups and writing of the 'Students' Guide'.

12-13> Trip to Bologna by bus. A **packed lunch is required**: please, let it be plastic-free and use a reusable bottle to refill with water! A special guide will show us the town centre!

14:30> Visiting the Europe Direct Information Centre.

16:30> Two groups will be visiting the ancient Teatro Anatomico and Sala dello Stabat, Palazzo Poggi 33: the ancient Alma Mater Studiorum building of Bologna.

18> Back to Cento by bus and dinner with the families. The teachers are free.

Wednesday 26th Oct.

Visiting and sightseeing CENTO

8-12> Starting from the school, we'll have a walk until our beautiful and ancient Rocca and Mrs. Maria Teresa Alberti will show us part of the library and the inside yard of it. We will reach the Archivio Storico where the oldest documents of Cento are kept, and you'll be able to see how water had influenced our areas.

Mr. Franco Grandi will show us Cento and its most antique part, with the Jewish Ghetto.

12-14> Relax and **plastic-free packed lunch** in the town centre (Piazza or Ghetto).

14-16> Walk until the Bosco Integrale, a big naturalistic area recently refreshed, where arch. Chiara Pellizzola will show us the entire project.

16:30> Free time and dinner with the families.

20> the teacher may have dinner together at 'Mascalzone', Renazzo. We will pick you up!

Thursday 27th Oct.

Tour by BOAT on the PO RIVER

8-12> Starting from Cento's BUS STATION to reach Ferrara by bus. There we will take a boat for 2:30hr with a guide who's going to show us the peculiarities of our naturalistic areas, travelling through the Ferrara Darsena, straight to the Po River (the longest in Italy). **A plastic-free packed lunch is required!** Don't forget your reusable bottle!

12-13:30> chilling and lunch.

14-16> Tour of Ferrara's city centre, the Jewish Ghetto, the Cathedral, and the Walls.

17-18> Back to Cento by bus at the bus station and dinner with the families. The teachers are free.

Friday 28th Oct.

Activities at school

8-10> job and class shadowing divided in groups.

10-10:30> Break.

11-13> Activities about the Erasmus+ project's topics and conclusion of the 'Students' Guide'. Workshop.

13> Lunch with the families and afternoon at home.

19:30> 'Pizzata' at Samanta restaurant (it's on us!).

Saturday 29th Oct.

Departures

- **Spanish** friends will leave at 10:25 from the Bologna Marconi Airport (be at the airport at least 2 ½ before!).
- **Portuguese** friends will leave at 17:35 from Milano Malpensa Airport. We suggest booking a train earlier (Italo or Frecciarossa) and families will take you to the Bologna Central Train Station in time to reach Milano.

Suggestions

- Each one should bring a FFP2 face mask, because in some places it's still required.
- Bring your own reusable metal bottle, in order not to use plastic, at least during this week.
- Take with you some money for your own expenses. We will offer you two dinners, the tickets to travel, the boat trip.
- Remember to bring umbrellas or raincoats: October is still a warm month here, but some days may be rainy and foggy.
- Take with you your usual medicines or special products, just in case you need them.
- Bring pens and a notebook.

For the teachers:

- the tickets' fees at the Bologna Museum are €3.50/each.
- lunches and dinner: between €20-35, depending on the restaurants.
At your hotel Europa you'll find an excellent restaurant, with typical Emilian dishes for your lunches, but in the town centre you'll find also good bars, Italian restaurants, Chinese and Sushi restaurants, kebab, and pizzerias.
