CRITERIA FOR PARTICIPANTS I

a) **SELECTION CRITERIA OF STUDENTS**

according to the criteria fixed in the project application:

- be able to host partners visiting their country;
- Have obtained the average mark in their behaviour;
- Possess good social skills and abilities in order to communicate confidently in different cultural environments;
- The target group is pupils between the ages of 15-18 years. Working groups of 16 pupils will be selected at each of the participating schools.
Every 8th (alternating) pupil will take part in the ste and will act as disseminators for their whole school community

CRITERIA FOR PARTICIPANTS II

- Pupils should be able to host partners in families
- Obligation to possess the EU Covid-19 Certificate (Green pass)
 - To check the Green Pass for participants, an information event will be organised at least one week before the exchange.
 - All the collected data will be treated according to the GDPR.
- Respect the various measures in place for travellers of the hosting country (<https://reopen.europa.eu/en/>)
- If needed, new selection of working groups due to the adapted Covid-19 participation criteria
- Thinking about the possibility to take out an additional risk insurance to cover cancellation fees due to the pandemic.
