TASKS & RESPONSIBILITIES

Austrian school (coordinator) will:

BUDGET & MOBILITY TOOL

Therefore, each school has stipulated an agreement with their own National Agency. For this reason, all partners have checked the current situation of their own budget verifying all the costs not only by receipts and invoices but also structuring them according to the application and to the provided Mobility Tool Platform (**project management and implementation, travel costs and individual support**).
