Programme Overview

Sunday 6th Nov.

Arrival of the participants (except Sweden and Portugal):

- **Austria: 15:59 train station**
- **Greece: 19:05 airport**
- **Spain: 22:40 airport**

We will pick you up at the Bologna Marconi Airport or Stazione Centrale dei Treni (for Austria) and take you to Europa Hotel in Cento. Since some of you arrive late in the evening, we suggest you can have your dinner at the hotel, which is one of the most typical Emilian restaurants in Cento! We will pick you up at the hotel at 7:30am on Monday morning and get you to the school.

Monday 7th Nov.

Arrival of the Swedish and Portuguese participants:

Teachers are involved in the presentation of the project at school, so we will manage to send a car.

8-10 > Tour of the school buildings, presentation of the areas, the offices, the Erasmus+ corner, tour of the laboratories.

10:15-10:45 > break: cappuccino/caffè and cornetto at the school bar.

11-12 > Some of the exchange students will show their activities done during the former week. Organisation of the activities and explanation of the programme.

12-13 > Presentation of the Erasmus+ project to the school; welcoming of the Headmaster Dott.ssa Annamaria Barone Freddo and staff. Welcoming presents will be given to you.

13-14:30 > DISSEMINATION and plastic-free buffet lunch at school with some Emilian baked specialties (on us!) – together with the school staff.

19:30 > Dinner at Signora Emilia restaurant and tour of Cento by night.

Tuesday 8th Nov.

Conference and workshop with the expert + BOLOGNA

8-9:30 > Dott. Alessandro Mingotti, teacher at the University of Bologna, will show us some of the usages of water in the industrial and electrical fields.

9:30-9:45 > Break at the school bar.

10-11 > Job shadowing.

11:25-12:15 > Trip to Bologna, 11:25 by bus.

12:30-13:30 > Lunch at Mercato di Mezzo.

14 > Tour of Bologna: San Petronio, Santo Stefano, city centre.

16-17 > We will be visiting the ancient Teatro Anatomico and Sala dello Stabat, Palazzo Poggi 33: the ancient Alma Mater Studiorum building of Bologna + a typical window on the hidden canals of Bologna

17:50 > Back to Cento and free time dinner.

Wednesday 9th Nov.

Visiting and sightseeing CENTO

8-11 > Starting from the school, we'll have a walk until our beautiful and ancient Rocca Castle and Mrs. Maria Teresa Alberti will show us part of the library and the inside yard of it. We will reach the Archivio Storico where the oldest documents of Cento are kept, and you'll be able to see how water had influenced all our areas (the symbol of Cento is a crayfish!), with the Jewish Ghetto and S.Biagio church.

12> Free afternoon.

14-15 > NOT COMPULSORY: visiting the Gipsoteca, a cultural and short supply chain spot where every Thursday a market takes place; Giorgia will show us the entire project (**please, tell me if you're coming in advance!**)

20 > Who wants to join, dinner at Cencio, the most ancient Osteria in town.

Thursday 10th Nov.

Trip to VENICE: a sustainable and floating city.

7:30-13:30 > trip to Venice by train (7:30 – 2hrs trip). We'll be starting from Cento by car and then visiting the St. Erasmo island (nomen omen!) and its exquisite and useful vegetable gardens, which give food to the city...and to us too on this day! We will travel by boat (vaporetto) too, so take your medicines with you if you know you are going to be sick! Advice: Chiara Spadaro, on the bees in Venice – book 'L'arcipelago delle api'.

14-16:30> Venice city centre: Piazza San Marco, Palazzo Ducale, San Marco's Church, il Campanile.

Suggestions:

Expenses:

- the tickets at the Bologna Museum are €3.50
- train to Venice: €24 roundtrip
- lunch at 'Orti di Venezia', tasting of typical food and wine: €30
- Venice daily boat ticket: €21 (most convenient)
- lunches and dinner: between €20-40, depending on the restaurants (here we usually don't give tips).

At your hotel Europa you'll find an excellent restaurant, with typical Emilian dishes for your lunches or dinners, but in the town centre you'll find also good bars, Italian restaurants, Chinese and Sushi restaurants, kebab, and pizzerias.
