In the evening, families, teachers, and students were invited at school to disseminate the project, while eating and drinking together.














#### 25<sup>th</sup> October 2022, Tuesday

In the morning, Dr. Alessandro Mingotti, ex-student at ISIT Bassi-Burgatti, showed us many usages of water, in the industrial, chemical, energetic fields, as well as its huge importance for the human beings and living creatures. We shared a lot of ideas on how we deal with water every day in our countries.

Then, the groups of students divided into their exchange parts, Sevilla, and Madeira, and were assigned of different workshops. They had to translate and create two posters in English, following these topics: 'how to save a marine turtle' and 'the oceanic and sea plastic'. They are now hung in our Erasmus+ Corner!

In the afternoon we all went to Bologna and visited its amazing medieval town centre: the two towers of Garisenda and Asinelli, Maggiore Square, San Petronio's Church, the Anatomic Theatre at Archiginnasio and took a tasty Italian ice-cream altogether! We also met people from the Europe Direct Centre, were gifted of many gadgets, and found out useful news about the European mobility.



#### 26th October 2022, Wednesday

In the morning the group had an interesting visit inside the Rocca Castle, the most ancient building of Cento. Thanks to Maria Teresa Alberti, responsible of the library, we were told a lot of information about Cento's medieval and renaissance periods, as well as some gossips written in the local chronicles. Then, we were also shown of lots of curious manuals, chronicles, and documents, together with old pictures, representing Cento's life during the centuries, when it still was a town on the water.

In the afternoon, we walked until the Bosco Integrale, a vast green area, where the architect Chiara Pellizzola told us about the huge project linked to it: workshops, laboratories with children and old people, a park, areas where to relax thanks to external activities like yoga or pilates, music festivals and much more will be set there.







# 27th October 2022, Thursday

Boat day! We went to Ferrara by bus and then had a boat trip on the Nena, an old ferryboat taken from Venice and reused as touristic transport. There we spotted different species of animals, birds and plants living in the canal which conducts directly to the Po River.

We had a long walk through the ancient walls of the city and visited some landmarks in the centre, as San Giorgio's Cathedral, Trento-Trieste Square, the Ghetto and Delle Volte Street, the Estense Castle and Municipale Square with the well-known covered stair.

During the morning the students took part in different lessons, divided by classes, together with all the students: some followed English and Spanish courses, some Italian and Science, some Philosophy and Mechanics. Then we spent the rest of the time finishing the workshops and all the exchange students finally received their certificates.
